Educational & Chartered Psychologist, Speaker, Author & Expert Witness, Lindsay is widely recognised as an expert in the range of specific learning difficulties, SEN & mainstream education. In 2002 she was appointed CBE for services to Education & Dyslexia. She was awarded the Outstanding Lifetime Academic Achievement Award by the British Dyslexia Association (BDA) in 2011. She has lectured extensively as keynote speaker internationally since the late 1980s & advises governments, trades unions, policy makers, lawyers, schools, psychologists & parents.

Lindsay is an Associate Fellow & Chartered Scientist of the British Psychological Society & a Fellow of both the International Academy of Research in Learning Disabilities & the Royal Society of Arts. She is a member of the Association of Child Psychologists in Private Practice & of the Association for Child & Adolescent Mental Health (ACAMH). She is registered to practice with the Health Professions Council.

Lindsay held the posts of Education Director & Deputy CEO of the BDA until 2003. She has many years experience as a teacher, teacher trainer & SENCo. She has published a considerable body of material both theoretical & practical & published the first groundbreaking book linking 'Glue Ear' with Dyslexia.

Lindsay has a private practice at her home in Watford assessing children, students & adults facing challenges in learning. She is authorised to assess for public examinations.
